



This week: Newly constructed desert homes

1 ▶ Palm Springs, Calif. Elissa Scrafano Architects designed this three-bedroom minimalist home. The house has a contemporary kitchen and features wood floors, high wood ceilings, and glass walls along the entire back, facing the pool.
