Opportunity to buy 'a thriving, established,' charming Sonoma inn

ypically homes published in the getaway section represent seclusion and exclusivity. That's not necessarily the case for 171 W. Spain St. in Sonoma, a seven-bedroom that operates as An Inn 2 Remember.

Found just off Sonoma Plaza, the inn is made of a pair of vintage residences. There's the front house, a Victorian cottage built in 1869 and finished with fish scale shingles, and a rear residence that was completed in 1910.

"The location is superb, near top-flight restaurants, tasting rooms, City Hall Plaza Park, Sonoma Valley Museum and the renowned Mission," said Tina Shone of Sotheby's International Realty, who is listing the residence/inn for \$3.495 million. "There's the bike path and hiking trails, which allow guests to indulge in Sonoma's rich history. This offering consists of two structures, furnishings and a thriving, established business. It could also make a delightful private residence."
